All campers will live in one of our three new bunk houses with two college age camp counselors living in each house. The camp compound will have access to large screen TV's, pool tables, foosball, ping pong, basketball, a swimming pool and a Wii.

Check is at 9 am each Monday, and check out is 1 pm on Friday with an awards ceremony for friends and family. Summer Overnight Camp is available to those between the ages of 13 and 18. Groups max out at 18 campers per session. Camp times and prices are below. Discounts are provided for siblings. Transportation to and from DFW Airport or Love Field is available for an additional \$50 charge. Sunday night check ins may also be accommodated for an additional \$150 charge.

DALLAS WATERSPORTS COMPLEX – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- What is a cable ski park? Where is the DWC located?
- Are there existing cable ski parks in the United States?
- How many people are you expecting? How much will it cost?
- What hours will the park be open? Is the water safe?
- What facilities are being proposed?

What is a cable ski park, where is it located?

Cable-skiing allows people to water-ski and wakeboard without a boat. It works just like a chair-lift at a mountain ski area. A horizontal cable, suspended on towers and powered by a quiet electric engine, pulls water-skiers and wake-boarders around a lake. Dallas Watersports Complex will be located on Fishtrap Lake, just minutes from Downtown, Oak Cliff, the Medical District, the Park Cities and Uptown. The lake is conveniently located at the intersection of Inwood/Hampton and Singleton in West Dallas. The lake is within a 25 minute drive of 6.3M residents in DFW. Just take Inwood over the Trinity River and look for signs.

Are there existing cable ski parks in the United States?

Yes, there are nine cable parks in the U.S, a small park outside of New Braunfels and one near Cresson, Texas. Fort Worth has a system 2.0 cable park and Kansas, Oklahoma, Ohio and Florida also have cable parks. There are more than 160 parks throughout Europe and Asia.

How many people are you expecting? How much will it cost?

The average daily attendance is expected to be between 100 and 150 riders and will not have a significant impact on traffic in the area. The cost will vary by season; Dallas Watersports Complex expects to offer early bird specials as low as \$20 for 3 hours.

What will be the hours of operation? Is the water safe?

Dallas Watersports Complex will be open 9:00 a.m. to dusk every day. The DWC will be open to all ages, but all participants must be able to swim 50 yards on their own and sign a release form. The water in Fishtrap Lake has been tested and is within EPA standards for contact recreation sports. In fact, 300 lakes, rivers and creeks — including Lake Granbury, the Brazos River, Caddo Lake, and the Colorado River below Austin's Town Lake — are on the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's watch list of "impaired" waters. **Not** on the list? Fishtrap Lake.

What type of facilities will be at the Dallas Watersports Complex?

The DWC facilities include:

- Two state-of-the-art cableways, one runs clockwise, the other will run counterclockwise
- Two beginner "2.0" cable system that carries one skier between two towers
- Pro-shop, snack bar, free WIFI
- Sand Volleyball, tether ball, ping pong, basketball and other fun and games
- Full-service restaurant and large viewing decks
- Room to add more 2.0 systems and outdoor recreational facilities, such as skateboard park, basketball, rock climbing, sand volleyball and zip lines.

DWC Summer Camps –Frequently Asked Questions.

➤ **Does my child need to know how to wakeboard?**

No! Every experience level is welcome. From beginner to advanced DWC will work with each camper at their level of experience and campers will be grouped by experience level. With multiple cables, the DWC has the ability to accommodate campers of all levels

➤ **Does my child have to know how to swim?**

Yes! It is very important for your child to be comfortable and confident in and around the water. Wakeboarding is all about being in open water. In order for your child to get the most out of their DWC experience they will have to pass an open water swim test.

➤ **Do you provide all wakeboarding equipment?**

Yes! All wakeboarding equipment is provided by DWC. Each camper will be issued: One US Coast Guard Approved life jacket, one wakeboard with boots, and one wakeboarding helmet.\

➤ **My child has special dietary needs. Can DWC work with those needs?**

Yes! Please give us as much information about your child's special dietary needs so we can work with our food suppliers and food preparers to accommodate those needs. Please understand that DWC will need adequate notice prior to your child's arrival at camp to make those preparations. Late notifications may not be able to be accommodated.

For Overnight Camps

➤ **Can my child room with a friend?**

Yes! Please list any roommate requests on your registration form. We will take requests on a first come first serve basis. Late requests may not be able to be accommodated as sessions are filled.

➤ **What is DWC's counselor to camper ratio?**

DWC offers one counselor to every eight overnight campers. Two counselors will stay in the DWC cabins with the overnight campers.

➤ **Can my child be dropped off early/late or picked up early/late?**

Yes! Arrangements must be made at least 30 days prior to the start of your child's session. There are no refunds for late arrivals or early departures.

➤ **Can DWC pickup or drop off my child at the airport?**

Yes! There is an additional transportation fee for this service and arrangements must be made at least 60 days prior to the start of your child's session; pickup and drop off is available at Love Field and DFW airport.

➤ **Can my child stay through the weekend?**

Yes! Weekend accommodations are available on a first come, first serve basis for an additional fee. DWC needs 60 days advanced notice for this service and fees will vary depending on activities you would like your child to participate in.
